HomeWarming helps income-qualified Nova Scotians save money on heating bills and feel more comfortable year-round.

We all deserve to be comfortable in our homes, regardless of income. But too many Nova Scotians struggle to keep warm and pay the bills. HomeWarming helps qualifying homeowners save money on heating bills and feel more comfortable year-round – at no cost to the homeowner.

Clean Foundation and Efficiency Nova Scotia work together to offer these efficiency upgrades. Clean Foundation delivers the electric heat portion of the program through a generous contribution from Nova Scotia Power. Efficiency Nova Scotia delivers the program to non-electrically heated homes with funding from the Province of Nova Scotia.

Why HomeWarming?

In a typical house, 80 per cent of the heat loss is caused by drafts and poor insulation. Upgrades like improving insulation and draft-proofing can help keep a home cooler in the summer and warmer in the winter. And since heating and cooling makes up around 60 per cent of energy costs, reducing these bills can make other household expenses more manageable.

Help from HomeWarming could be the difference between paying bills or buying groceries.

Who is eligible for HomeWarming?

HomeWarming is offered to income-qualified homeowners across the province. You can apply for HomeWarming if:

- Your income is under the levels shown in the following chart
- You own a single unit home located in Nova Scotia and can provide proof of ownership
- You live in your home year-round as your primary residence, and you do not plan to sell it in the near future
- Your home has not participated in past versions of the program (Unsure? Call us toll free at 1-877-434-2136 to confirm)

Income Eligibility Chart*	
Number of people living in your home	Maximum annual household income (Line 236 from your Notice of Assessment)
1 person	\$20,952
2 to 4 people	\$38,931
5 or more people	\$55,444

*Based on Low Income Cut-offs (LICOs) before-tax figures set by Statistics Canada

How do people apply?

Homeowners can speak confidentially with a Service Advisor about their eligibility and access application forms by calling **1-877-434-2136** (toll free), or by visiting HomeWarming.ca.

Five ways you can help people in your community:

- **Tell others.** Share program information and applications with people in your community. Printed applications and promotional material are available at no charge, upon request.
- **Refer applicants.** If your town, district, or county offers a low-income property tax exemption, you may be able to directly refer people to the program and improve ease of access. Contact us for more information on direct referral requirements.
- **Follow us.** You can share real-time information directly with your community. You can also contact us for engaging content to use on your website, in newsletters and publications.
- **Contact us.** If you would like a HomeWarming representative to present program information at a Council meeting or relevant public event, we would be happy to attend.
